The traveling terrier also made the news during his photo shoot for an upcoming book at the Skipjack Nathan of Dorchester. "The heritage, educational value, and beauty of the Nathan is very important to us," says Mr. Pish author K. S. Brooks. "In addition to writing about her in Mr. Pish's next book, we decided to honor her on the cover of his 2012 calendar."
